Founded in 1965, the Chinese American Planning Council (CPC) is one of the largest non-profit providers of educational, social and community services for Asian Americans in the United States. It now serves over 8,000 people daily through over 70 programs in 29 locations citywide. It administers community services, child care, youth services, workforce development, senior services, home attendant services, housing and cultural services. CPC's mission is to improve the quality of life of Chinese Americans in New York City by providing access to services, skills and resources towards the goal of economic sufficiency and integration into the American mainstream.

华策会於一九六五年成立，是纽约市最早的华裔非牟利社会服务机构，它一直致力於社区发展，教育和社会服务工作。起初，它的工作基地只不过是唐人街上一间小舖面，而今天，它已成为美国境内最大的亚裔服务社团之一。华策会在曼哈顿，皇后区和布碌崙都有不少分机构，每天在二十九个办事处，透过超过七十多个服务计划，向大约八千多人提供各种服务。华策会的主要服务项目包括：社区服务，职业培训，托儿中心，青少年及年长者服务，公平房屋计划，文化艺术和社区发展计划等。

The CPC Literacy Program opened its doors to students in 1998, as an expansion of the successful Workforce Development Division. Over the last decade, we have experienced enormous growth, both in the number of students we serve and in the scope of our offerings. Every year, hundreds of adult students enroll in our classes to learn the necessary skills for communication and professional development.
